## Additional Info/Answers to Questions

New Service Times: 9:15AM \& 11:00AM on Sundays.
Second Sunday of Every Month: One service at 11:00AM under the tent.
Note for 9:15 \& 11:00AM: There will be no more overflow in the lobby for those services, but the family room right outside the sanctuary will still be available during those times.

Little Ones Ministry: The Little Ones Ministry will be available every Sunday at every service time.

Do we have to pick a specific service?: You can decide to come to either Sunday service.

Communion/Baptisms: We will take communion once a month at the outdoor service under the tent. Any baptisms will also take place during that service.

What will service outside look like?: We are planning to purchase or rent a tent that will be able to accommodate all of us in one service. We will set up chairs and have audio/visual in a similar way to our indoor service. Our order of service will function much the same as it does inside.

What if there's inclement weather for outside?: Our plan is to gauge weather conditions by Friday of that week and make an announcement for Sunday. If there is indeed inclement weather, in our best judgment, we will make an announcement on Friday that we are having our customary 9:15 \& 11:00AM services instead of our outside service.

Note: We will not move the outside service to the following week if there is bad weather. We will follow our existing service schedule and plan to meet outside the following month.

Parking: To maintain better flow of traffic as we transition to two services, we would like to request different lots for both services. Covenant Members:

Those who come to the 9:15AM - please park at General Greene first

Those who come to the 11:00AM - please park at Senior Resources first

This will allow better flow between services and will also allow visitors to park in our main parking lot near the church.
